REQUEST FOR BIDS – GRAVEL PRODUCTION

Sealed bids will be received until 9:00 a.m. April 6, 2016 at the office of the Kalkaska County Road Commission, 1049 Island Lake Road, Kalkaska, MI 49646, for the manufacturing, processing, and stockpiling 20,000 yd³ of 22A modified road gravel. All bids must be received in a sealed envelope clearly marked as “Gravel Processing “. Bids will be opened at 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, April 6, 2016 at the regularly scheduled Finance Committee meeting. Awarded bids will be approved at the regularly scheduled meeting on Wednesday, April 13, 2016 at 9:30 a.m.

** Clay is available from Kalkaska County Road Commission clay pit located in Section 26, T27N, R7W, Kalkaska Township. Access is by private drive, south off M-72, 2½ miles east of M-66. Transportation will be the responsibility of the successful contractor. No royalties will be charged for the clay used for gravel production under this contract.

Specifications and Testing Interval: 2012 MDOT Standard Specifications for Construction, Section 902, grading requirements – 22A Modified to require a minimum of 8% loss by washing and 30-55% passing the No. 8 sieve. The successful contractor shall provide documentation of test results on materials produced. The testing interval will be set at a minimum of 1 test per 1,000 tons of processed 22A gravel.

Method of Measurement: Material will be measured and paid by the ton based on weight from stacking belt scales, or by weighing across contractor provided certified truck scales. Conversion will be 3,000# (lbs.) per yd³.

Damage Liability and Insurance: The Contractor will save harmless and indemnify Kalkaska County, the Board of Kalkaska County Road Commissioners, and the Kalkaska County Road Commission against all claims for damage to public or private property and for injuries to persons arising out of and during progress and to the completion of the work. The Contractor will file a certification that he/she carries insurance with minimum limits of \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$1,000,000 aggregate on Bodily Injury Liability, \$1,000,000 each occurrence and \$1,000,000 aggregate on Property Damage Liability.

The undersigned has examined the proposal, specifications, and the location of the work described herein and is fully informed as to the nature of the work and the conditions relating to

its performance and understands that the quantities shown are approximate only and are subject to either increase or decrease.

The undersigned further proposes to do such extra work as may be authorized by the Kalkaska County Road Commission, prices for which are not included in the itemized bid. Compensation shall be made on the basis agreed upon in writing before such extra work is begun.

General Conditions:

- The successful contractor is responsible to ensure all employees involved in the gravel production/mining operations covered under this bid have had the required MIOSHA and MSHA training and in compliance with regulations.
- The successful contractor is responsible to ensure all M.D.E.Q ground water and sedimentation procedures are followed to prevent discharge of sediment.
- The Kalkaska County Road Commission retains the right to review test results during production and to conduct independent testing of material.
- The Kalkaska County Road Commission will not accept invoices containing fuel surcharges or additional charges that have not been approved by the Kalkaska County Road Commission or its representative.
- The Kalkaska County Road Commission reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity or defect in accept that bid which, in the opinion of the Road Commission, is in the best interest of the Road Commission.
- The Kalkaska County Road Commission reserves the right to adjust quantities to stay within the 2016 budget.
