

Request for Proposal

West Sharon Road over Manistee River Construction Engineering Services

The Kalkaska County Road Commission will receive sealed proposals until **9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 10, 2016**, for construction engineering services for the West Sharon Road over Manistee River Construction Project in Garfield Township; bids will be awarded at the Regular Meeting on May 11, 2016. This is a federal-aid funded project. All FHWA standards must be followed.

This Federal Aid Project was in the April 1, 2016 MDOT letting and is anticipated to be awarded to Davis Construction, Inc. Construction to begin no earlier than June 14, 2016.

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Project Facts

The project includes but is not limited to: existing superstructure removal, bridge superstructure reconstruction with 17-inch prestressed concrete box beams, road approach construction, guardrail, and slope restoration.

Additional Information

Construction Engineering Services will include: Project Engineer, Field Manager administration, daily inspection, material testing and construction staking.

This Federal Aid Project was in the April 1, 2016 MDOT letting and is anticipated to be awarded to Davis Construction, Inc. Construction to begin no earlier than June 14, 2016. Preconstruction meeting is anticipated to be scheduled promptly after award of CE services as soon as the week of May 16th, 2016.

Consultants and their sub-consultants shall be experienced in MDOT Bridge Construction. The successful bidder shall have a Professional Engineer who is registered in the State of Michigan, who shall serve as Project Engineer.

All Field Manager administration shall be included in the bid. Successful bidder will be required to have a certified Office Technician and provide all Field Manager administration including but not limited to: Filing, Inspector's Daily Reports, Material Certifications, Contract Modifications and Estimates. This will be required through final file review and project closeout.

Successful bidder shall be responsible for all construction inspection for the project.

The successful bidder shall be certified in and responsible for all material testing including but not limited to: concrete, density, aggregates, and asphalt.

The successful bidder shall be certified in and responsible for SESC Inspections.

Successful bidder shall be responsible for all staking for the project.

Successful bidder shall coordinate and attend all required meetings, including but not limited to preconstruction meeting, and keep the Kalkaska County Road Commission informed on the project progress and notify the Kalkaska County Road Commission of any changes.

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Submittal Requirements

Bidders shall submit a 1-2 page description of how the company can best provide the requested services to Kalkaska County Road Commission, resumes of all key project personnel along with a list of their certifications and a completed copy of the attach, "Construction Engineering Services Proposal Sheet". Proposals must be submitted in an envelope clearly marked, "**Request for Proposal – West Sharon Road over Manistee River Project - Construction Engineering Services**", prior to **9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, May 10, 2016**.

Plans can be reviewed at the Kalkaska County Road Commission office located at 1049 Island Lake Road, Kalkaska, MI. The Board reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to award in the best interest of the Kalkaska County Road Commission.
