

Request for Proposal

County Road 612 Construction Engineering Services

The Kalkaska County Road Commission will receive sealed proposals for construction engineering services until 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 7, 2017 for the County Road 612 Construction Project at which time they will be opened and read aloud. This project is from C.R. 571 to East Shore Drive, approximately two (2) miles in Coldsprings/Excelsior Township. This is a HRRR (Safety) and a Federal Aid funded project. All FHWA standards must be followed.

This Project will be let in a MDOT letting on June 2, 2017 with construction to begin no earlier than July 10, 2017.

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Project Facts

The project includes but is not limited to pulverizing existing asphalt, adding gravel, drainage, culvert replacement, widening and paving of hot mix asphalt.

The existing surface is a rural asphalt road. The new roadway will consist of 3" hot mix asphalt lanes and shoulders.

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Additional Information

Construction Engineering Services will include: Project Engineer, Field Manager administration, daily inspection, material testing and construction staking.

This Project will be let in a MDOT letting on June 2, 2017 with construction to begin no earlier than July 10, 2017.

The successful bidder shall have a Professional Engineer who is registered in the State of Michigan, who shall serve as Project Engineer.

All Field Manager administration shall be included in the bid. Successful bidder will be required to have a certified Office Technician and provide all Field Manager administration including but not limited to: Filing, Inspector's Daily Reports, Material Certifications, Contract Modifications and Estimates. This will be required until project closeout.

Successful bidder shall be responsible for all construction inspection for the project.

The successful bidder shall be certified in and responsible for all material testing including but not limited to: concrete, density, aggregates, and asphalt.

The successful bidder shall be certified in and responsible for SESC Inspections.

Successful bidder shall be responsible for all staking for the project.

Successful bidder shall coordinate and attend all required meetings, including but not limited to preconstruction meeting, and keep the Kalkaska County Road Commission informed on the project progress and notify the Kalkaska County Road Commission of any changes.

Bidders MUST fill out attached, "Construction Engineering Services Proposal Sheet". Proposals must be submitted in an envelope clearly marked, "Request for Proposal – C.R. 612 Project - Construction Engineering Services", no later than 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 7, 2017.

This will be awarded based on a not to exceed price.

Plans can be reviewed at the Kalkaska County Road Commission office located at 1049 Island Lake Road, Kalkaska, MI. The Board reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to award in the best interest of the Kalkaska County Road Commission.
