AMENDED POLICY FOR SIGN PLACEMENT/REPLACEMENT

NON-STANDARD SIGNS:

(Non-standard signs may include but are not limited to: Neighborhood Watch, Deaf children; No Parking (by police order), etc., and are subject to placement restrictions.)

Initial Installation	Actual Costs/Time & Materials
Replacement/Maintenance:	Actual Costs/Time & Materials

PRIVATE ROAD NAME SIGNS:

Initial Installation	\$200.00 per sign
Replacement/Maintenance:	Actual Costs/Time & Materials

COUNTY ROAD NAME SIGNS:

(New signs not previously placed)

Initial Installation	\$200.00 per sign
Replacement/Maintenance:	

Kalkaska County Road Commission will maintain thereafter at no charge.
However, replacement will be limited to one sign per year.

All requests for new and/or replacement signs in Townships must be made in writing and forwarded to the Kalkaska County Road Commission via facsimile, regular mail, and/or in person along with the information stating the sign needed and exact location of sign to be placed. A copy of the Township's Board Minutes approving request must also accompany request.
